ANNOTATION

The history of pharmacy, although it has a long, independent period of development back in time, is today seen as part of social pharmacy.

The history of pharmacy is a science that studies the development of pharmaceutical knowledge and pharmaceutical practice in the closest relationship with the development of human society, with the development of medicine, chemistry, biology, philosophy and economics, with the cultural history of peoples of all eras and times. Therefore, it is one of the main theoretical disciplines in pharmacy, which clarifies the evolution in the development of drug knowledge in relation to the changing socio-economic conditions, the professional role and problems of pharmacy.

Purpose of teaching in the discipline - to acquaint pharmacy students in general with the history, theory and practice of pharmacy as a socially significant area of public health care.

Acquired competences - through this introductory course, students get the opportunity to learn about the scope and directions of their future professional realization in society as specialists, as well as about the educational institution and the content of the individual disciplines during their studies.

Student evaluation is based on an exam for overall preparation.
